- il finira

- nous finirons
- vous finirez
- ils finiront

Example with *attendre* (to wait), a -re verb:

- j'attendrai
- tu attendras
- il attendra
- nous attendrons
- vous attendrez
- ils attendront

Common Irregular Verbs in Futur Simple

Some French verbs have irregular stems in the futur simple tense, although they use the same endings as regular verbs. Memorizing these irregular stems is essential for correct conjugation and comprehension.

List of Common Irregular Verbs

The following verbs have irregular stems in the futur simple:

- **être** → ser- (je serai)
- **avoir** → aur- (tu auras)
- **aller** → ir- (il ira)
- **faire** → fer- (nous ferons)
- **venir** → viendr- (vous viendrez)
- **voir** → verr- (ils verront)
- **savoir** → saur-
- **pouvoir** → pourr-

- **devoir** → devr-
- **vouloir** → voudr-
